Diane Leopold is director, executive vice president and president & chief executive officer—Gas Infrastructure Group of Dominion Energy Midstream GP, LLC, the general partner of Dominion Energy Midstream Partners, LP. She is also president and chief executive officer of the Gas Infrastructure Group of Dominion Energy, Inc.

Her business unit distributes natural gas to approximately 2.3 million customer accounts in five states, and operates nearly 15,000 miles of gathering, storage and transmission pipeline and one of the largest underground storage complexes in the world. Leopold joined Dominion in 1995 and has held various operational, project management, and commercial and financial management roles throughout the company.



She chairs the board of directors of the Interstate Natural Gas Association of America and is a member of the board of the American Gas Association. Leopold also serves on the board of trustees at Virginia Union University.
